ELECTRICAL SAFETY

Why do you need ARC Fault Circuit Breakers? They sense arcs caused by shorts and stop them, making ARC Fault Circuit Breakers smarter than traditional circuit breakers.

Comparing Ground Fault Circuit Interrupters (GFCI) and ARC Fault Circuit Breakers (ARC), ARC provides a certain level of GFI Protection—about 30ma versus .5ma or less than one-half second.

Both GFCI and ARC can be used on the same circuit, ARC in the panel and GFCI at the outlet, achieving two forms of protection. This may result in more nuisance trips of both ARC and GFCI, but the National Fire Protection Agency (NFPA) considers these trips to be "life savers".
